



## Ready and Waiting

**Trustees News** Despite our delayed opening, we were very pleased that the volunteer training in April went so well and would like to thank Amy, our trainer, and all those who took part for their enthusiasm and support. We are still waiting for news from the county council about our new handover date and will inform all our volunteers as soon as we have any new information.

The latest message from Nigel Thomas on 13<sup>th</sup> May states "The positive news is that we (LCC) have secured the funding to undertake the work required to separate access with the academy. The next stage will be to agree a heads of terms document with the academy that will formalise the separation."

MBCL do not expect to have to wait for the work to be carried out prior to the handover, and expect to hear more following a meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> May. We will have to sign new lease and grant agreements with LCC. We will also have refresher training to ensure that we are ready for action once a date is agreed.

### Events in the Library

Many of you will be aware of the Market Bosworth Festival which takes place in June. We are pleased to announce that the library is going to be a venue for one of the festival events – A Celebration of the Sonnet 1616-2016. This will take the form of a workshop and readings on Wednesday, 29<sup>th</sup> June 2.00 - 4.00 pm Admission free.
